I recall and not to far in the distant past standing in a cold dark warehouse on a concrete floor handing out cookie baskets to a hand full of kids we bussed in with old broken down vans with no seats. It was like, “Hey we got to do something for these kids why not!” I remember driving around one Christmas Eve with my friend Jimmy Duncan in a car full of dollar toys we purchased with some money we scraped together. All night we drove around blessing as many kids as possible. Some of them laughed and some cried when they received their gifts. I recall these being some of the best times in my life. We didn't have much but when we gave it away it seemed to multiply and the joy Jesus gave us in doing so nothing on this earth nothing can compare.

So, as you can imagine this year with thousands of kids being blessed with Christmas gifts in ten different locations in the City. With hundreds of volunteers showing up to help and several churches donating toys and gifts I was flooded with emotion and gratitude to how wonderful our God really is. But one thing sticks out in my mind the most when I look back on this Christmas 2005 and I would like to share it with you.

The Wednesday night before Christmas we had just finished giving out gifts at the Kennedy Place Apartment Projects when pulling away I noticed we needed gas for the truck. Normally we fill up before we go to the sites but because we were so busy it was overlooked so we pulled into a local gas station located in a very high crime rate neighborhood. Driving up to the gas pump I noticed the cashier sitting in a booth behind bullet proof glass. The Lord prompted me while I was pumping the gas. He said to me, “Give the woman a hand full of gifts now.” But I thought, “We don't have any we gave them all away.” So I called into the truck and asked a volunteer to get me some Christmas gifts and much to my surprise we had four girl's and boy's gifts left. After pumping the gas I walked up to the booth and knocked on the glass and shouted, “We have some gifts for you!” With tears in her eyes she opened the door and asked me, “**How did you know? I was just praying for gifts for my neighbors kids. Their house burned down last night and the kids have nothing for Christmas.**” She gave me a big bear hug a kiss on the cheek and thanked God. As we drove away I glanced

back and saw her sharing the testimony with everyone in the store.

So that's the way it is folks as an old preacher friend of mine once said, “**Jesus has no other hands but ours.**” Remember that without your giving none of this would be possible. Who knows how far your gift will go maybe across town, out of state, or around the world. Who knows? I sure didn't the night I pulled into that gas station. Thank you so much for giving to the Lord.
