

New Season

This summer we will be implementing some changes that will in the next five to ten years enable this ministry to move into a new level of soul winning and personal development for Christians from all denominational backgrounds. These exciting changes will bring to pass a vision of reaching one-million inner-city children in the seven to ten year period.

First, our current property will be converted into men's and women's dormitory living space. This will allow us to train up to 12 new people a semester on a continual basis. These interns will be trained in all aspects of inner-city missions, soul winning, Bible study, worship and all practical aspects of living for God and being affective in his service. Most will return to their home churches or be sent to other mission fields, while some will remain as core staff personnel with Walking Faith Ministry.

Secondly, dynamic partnerships will be formed to launch the Children's Activity Center in smaller urban ghettos across America. We will target cities with populations under half-million people. These are areas we believe have been missed by many mainstream evangelical organizations and will bring much needed light to areas of darkness and desperation the Bible calls the "habitations of cruelty." This summer we will begin training a group in the City of Toledo, Ohio.

Thirdly, we are currently reconstructing our web-site to include new high-tech areas that will allow us to do interactive training and development with our partners. Also, we are looking for a way through video and other creative techniques to communicate the Gospel worldwide and to interact with other ministries of the same nature and mission calling as ours.

Never in the history of the world has the opportunity to carry out what Jesus said in Acts 1:8 been available to the children of God than it is in this very hour. How very exciting and how so very doable to obey these words, "But you shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."



The Children's Activity Center – Children's Activity Truck, part of Walking Faith Ministry, is a non-profit faith based organization dedicated to sharing the love of Jesus Christ to children and their families in Houston's crime and poverty ridden inner-city. We use a number of colorful fourteen foot storage trucks converted into a portable stages to bring weekly presentations of the gospel in skits, dramas, puppetry, and video right to the very doorstep of the children who so most desperately need it. Weekly visitations to the homes of attending children help us to share the life changing message of Jesus with the entire family and help the ministry to identify current needs both spiritual and physical that can be met in a timely fashion.

When we first started this ministry in the inner-city five years ago a man walked up to me and asked me a couple of questions that got my attention. "Why are you messing around with these ghetto kids? Do you really think it will make a difference?" He asked me these questions just a few weeks after we had been through a riot and several police actions in and around our ministry. It was a time when many of our staff including myself was feeling that there was a possibility that what we were doing wasn't working. Yea, you could say we lacked some faith at the time. **But you know when God's into something you just keep going no matter what and that's what we did.** Today, it's made a huge difference in thousands of kid's lives in Houston's inner-city and beyond. Below are just a few of the hundreds of other testimonies we collected from the kids this past week.

Taquisha age 13

"God has giving me a good life. I thank God for placing food on the table. He wakes me up everyday for school and to get up for Pastor Scott. (Taguisha rides the bus two hours across town everyday because her mom was evicted from their apartment) I learn more about the world since I have been going to the CAT Truck. Without God I wouldn't be there today. I become a better person since I go to Pastor Scott. I respect my dad, sisters, my brother and mom. Thank you Pastor Scott and God."

Kierra age 11

"God has done many things for me since I have been coming to CAT.
